Valid reasons for failure to complete academic credit include, but are not limited to:

- Documented medical condition or serious illness
- Documented family emergency
- Documented change of city and/or state residence
- Documented death of an immediate family member
- Documented military obligations
- Documented change in conditions of employment
- Other extraordinary/emergency circumstances, such as natural disasters or crimes

Attach **date-specific support documentation** from a third-party. Letters from family and friends are not acceptable. Documentation includes, but is not limited to:

- Letter from a physician or counselor
- Copy of a death certificate, obituary, or third-party documentation of death
- Accident reports, police reports, court records, etc.
- Rental agreements, utility bills, etc. to show relocation
- Copy of military orders
