How to obtain credit for industry certification

No later than three years after obtaining the certification, student must:


1. Be an active student in good standing at EFSC, currently enrolled in the program listed above. Student's major must reflect this program.
2. Satisfy all admissions requirements.
3. Student will follow degree requirements of the catalog in effect at the time major is declared
 - a. If student does not maintain continuous enrollment at EFSC, student will follow requirements of the catalog in effect at the time of readmission
4. student must complete **at least** 25% of the degree requirements through traditional coursework at EFSC.
5. Upon completion of the above requirements, student must submit the *Petition for Articulated Credit* form, **along with a legible copy of the certificate**, through the Office of Career and Technical Programs to the Office of the Registrar, CO Bldg 2-020, 1519 Clearlake Rd, Cocoa, FL 32922.
6. Industry certification must not be expired at the time credit is requested.

Address questions regarding this agreement to the appropriate EFSC program faculty, the EFSC Office of Career and Technical Programs, or the EFSC Office of the Registrar. This agreement shall be reviewed every two years, and will remain in effect until revoked or terminated by the College.
